1) Was it important to you to break this barrier, or were you just doing your job?

It still amazes me that showing up to work that day ultimately brought more awareness that this barrier needed to be broken-actually it needs to be shattered! Our historic flight has given me an enormous platform to inspire women, especially women of color, to pursue aviation as a career path. There's less than 100 African American women pilots that fly commercially in the United States, so there's still so much more work to be done.

2) Who is your inspiration?

I'm inspired by anyone that has the intestinal fortitude to step out on faith and go after their goals and dreams. Thanks to the various social media platforms, I read about such stories almost every day. It makes me want to set new and improved goals for myself. There are many trailblazers in aviation that have inspired me along my journey to the cockpit. But, by far the most influential and inspirational is my cousin, Herman Samuels. He is a retired American Airlines captain and ironically was a member of the first all male African American flight crew in the U.S. He continues to be an amazing mentor and friend!
