


scholarship. Special thanks go to Kim Hagerty, Scholarship Chair, who did a stand-out job as auctioneer.

WASP Gloria Heath, passed away on December 16, 2017, at the age of 95. A founding member of Flight Safety Foundation (FSF), Gloria was instrumental in the earliest efforts to disseminate aviation safety information worldwide. She was a long-time resident of Greenwich, Connecticut, and flew B-26 bombers during World War II. After the war, she was an original employee of FSF, working with founder Jerome Lederer, who described her efforts as indispensable. Gloria was inducted into the WAI Pioneer Hall of Fame in 1999.
