Message from WAI

A special thank you to our <u>#WAI18 sponsors</u> for helping to make the 29th Annual International Women in Aviation International Conference, March 22-24, 2018 in Reno, Nevada, <u>a very memorable gathering</u> for 3,200 attendees including 114 international representatives from 21 countries. The busy exhibit hall hosted 162 companies and organizations, representing all aspects of the aviation community.

More than 200 local girls, ages 8-17, participated in <u>Girls in Aviation Day Reno--</u>-a successful youth outreach program introducing youngsters to the possibilities of an aviation career through fun activities, role models, and an exhibit hall tour.

A highlight of each conference is the induction of women into the <u>WAI Pioneer Hall of Fame</u>. This year's honorees included: Bonnie Tiburzi Caputo, Kathleen Fox, and Brig. Gen. Linda K. McTague.

During the membership meeting, Marci Veronie of Avemco was named the new chair of WAI's board of directors and three board members (Abingdon Mullins, Deborah Hecker, and Brian Bolt) were re-elected, and Michaela Lucas was elected as a new board member.

During the three-day conference, 142 scholarships were distributed to WAI members at every stage of life for both academic use, lifestyle enhancement, and flight training including type ratings. A total of \$695,500 in scholarships was awarded putting the total amount of scholarships awarded since 1995 to \$11,495,581.
