Message from WAI

Last weekend, as the WASP celebrated its 75th Anniversary Homecoming at Avenger Field in Sweetwater, Texas, Women in Aviation International staff, members, friends, and families participated in <u>a nationwide project</u> <u>for Memorial Day 2018</u> to honor these pioneering World War II female aviators who have passed.

Nearly 100 WASP graves were visited and received decorations, flowers, flags, as well as video and photography tributes shared on #WomeninAviation social media with the hashtag #HonoringTheWASP.

<u>Texas Woman's University</u> provided the database of WASP gravesites so that WAI members and friends could locate graves near their local communities.

A contingent led by WAI Director Education and Industry Relations Cassandra Bosco and Director Communications Kelly Murphy decorated 40 WASP graves at Arlington National Cemetery.

WAI President Dr. Peggy Chabrian honored WASP Betty Stagg Turner (44-W-9), buried at Montogomery, Ohio. "The WASP are trailblazers," said Dr. Peggy Chabrian. "These valiant women not only aided the war effort, but opened the doors for future women military pilots."

WASP Louise Brand Hyde, 44-W-4, was honored along with the 38 WASP who died in service during Word War II in North Salem, New York.
