



WAI's Annual Conference Inspires

<u>The WAI2020 Conference</u> focused on workforce issues, professional development seminars, education sessions, and more during the organization's three-day annual gathering.

Other highlights include:

- A total attendance of nearly 4,500 includes 142 international representatives from 31 countries.
- The exhibit hall hosted 180 companies and organizations representing all aspects of the aviation community.
- WAI members received <u>151 scholarships</u> for both academic use, career enhancement, and flight training totaling \$831,365 in awards.
- Girls in Aviation Day Orlando hosted 250 attendees featuring 20 activity stations.
- This year's inductees to the WAI Pioneer Hall of Fame were: <u>Maj. Gen. Jeannie Leavitt</u>, <u>Patty Wagner</u>, and <u>U.S. Army's First Women Rotary Wing Aviators</u>.

During the WAI membership meeting, <u>Andrea Berry</u> was approved as a new board member, <u>Deborah Baugh</u> and <u>Brittney Tough</u> were re-elected. <u>Marci Veronie</u>'s term as board chair ended, and <u>Linda Markham</u>, Cape Air president, became the new WAI board chair.



WAI has now awarded over \$13.2 million scholarships since 1995.




A variety of education sessions and seminars were held during #WAI20 for attendees.
