Message from WAI

Currently, there are 56 scholarships offered for flight training, engineering, maintenance, dispatcher, and professional development for individuals in all stages of life.

Did you know that WAI members can apply for up to three scholarships each year? Applications are due November 10, 2020, and your membership must be current through March 2021.

In 2020, WAI awarded 151 scholarships valued at \$531,365 bringing the total scholarships awarded since 1995 to more than \$13.2 million.


