A major benefit of WAI membership is the opportunity to apply every year for scholarships. The 2021 growing list of scholarships are <u>now online</u> with more added weekly. Currently, there are 72 scholarships offered for flight training, drone instruction, engineering, maintenance, dispatcher, and professional development for individuals in all stages of life.

Did you know that WAI members can apply for up to three scholarships each year? Applications are due November 10, 2020, and your membership must be current through March 2021.

In 2020, WAI awarded 151 scholarships valued at \$531,365 bringing the total scholarships awarded since 1995 to more than \$13.2 million.

Nominations due TODAY for 2021 Pioneer Hall of Fame


Submit the <u>official nomination form</u> for the <u>2021 WAI</u>
