

WAI Concludes Successful First Virtual Conference!

The <u>32nd Annual International Women in Aviation</u>
<u>Conference</u> accomplished its goal to Connect. Engage.

Inspire. during WAI's first virtual conference on March 11-12 with all content available to registered attendees through March 31, 2021.

Highlights include: total attendance of more than 2,300 from around the world; exhibit hall with 105 companies and organizations; 101 scholarships distributed to members for a total of \$475,805 in awards; Girls in Aviation Day Reno on Saturday, March 13, where over 1,800 registrants from 16 countries were introduced to the possibilities of an aviation career, and more!
