



WAI Members Visit WASP Graves

WAI members and friends across the U.S. visited gravesites to remember the lives of the pioneering Women Airforce Service Pilots (WASP) during Memorial Day weekend in May 2021. For the fourth year, WAI paid tribute to these female World War II pilots who flew for the U.S. Army Air Forces from September 1942 to December 1944. In total, 1,102 women wore the silver wings of the WASP with 25 still living.

Photos of gravesite visits and tributes were shared on Women in Aviation social media channels and will be included in the July/August 2021 issue of *Aviation for Women* magazine.

"The women of the WASP were forgotten for so long. They were set aside at the end of the war, and many of them didn't talk about their experiences," Kate Landdeck, Texas Woman's University associate professor (home of the WASP archives), says. "In their later years, they began telling their stories again, working hard to inspire other women and girls to fly and to go after their own dreams, whatever they might be."

Partnering with TWU, WAI honors the WASP on Memorial Day weekend to recognize these female volunteers who served their country, and risked their lives to do their part for the war effort. The WASP play an important role as mentors, friends, and inspiration for whole new generations of women in aviation.

Congratulations Lauren Beam, WAI 54520, the winner of the CAE Women in Flight Scholarship for Southwest Airlines

Designation 225* Cadet Pathway! Lauren joins the ranks of CAE Women in Flight ambassadors who will continue to inspire the next generation of women in aviation.

WAI Founding Board Member and 2004 Pioneer Hall of Fame inductee, Nelda Lee, will address graduates of Auburn University during summer commencement weekend, Friday, August 6. Nelda is the second woman to earn an aerospace engineering degree from Auburn. After she graduated in 1969, Nelda began a 45-year career with Heritage McDonnell Douglas Co., now part of Boeing. She is recognized as a trailblazer in aerospace engineering and aviation and is the first civilian woman to fly the F-15 Eagle, logging more than an hour during testing.

Elise Wheelock, Capt. Olga Custodio, and Capt. Tammie Jo Shults will participate in this month's Air Race Classic as Piper Aircraft sponsored team named "Tres Aviadores". The three pilots will choose their own five-leg, one-day route and will launch from Boerne, Texas, the second week of June in a Piper Pilot 100. 
