WAI offers 100 scholarships

Women in Aviation International (WAI) has opened its WAI2023 scholarships for application TODAY!

Currently there are 100 scholarships valued at nearly \$630,000. The scholarships range from aerospace engineering, aviation maintenance, dispatcher, aviation manufacturing, general career enhancement as well as flight training. There are opportunities for private pilots, career pilots, as well as college students and international members.

Most scholarships can be applied for online unless otherwise noted. Have all your documents and information ready prior to preparing your applications. The deadline to submit applications is Wednesday, October 12, 2022. To apply, you must be a WAI member by October 1, 2022, and active through February 2023.

Congrats to Poppy Khoza!

Flight Safety Foundation honored Poppy Khoza,
South Africa's director of civil aviation, with the
Foundation's first Gloria Heath Trophy, which recognizes a
woman for notable achievements in civil aviation. Poppy is
the first woman to lead the South African Civil Aviation
Authority (SACAA). The Foundation heralded her leadership
of SACAA and the gains she has made during her tenure and
her role in promoting gender diversity in international
aviation.

Supported by Women in Aviation International, <u>the trophy</u> is named after Gloria Heath. Gloria is a 1999 WAI Pioneer Hall of Fame inductee, safety expert, and search-and-rescue pioneer who was the only woman among the group of innovators who created <u>Flight Safety Foundation</u> 75 years ago.



During the June 21 awards dinner at the National Press Club in Washington, D.C., Poppy Khoza was awarded the first Gloria Heath Trophy. The trophy was commissioned by sculptor <u>Laurie Barton</u>, WAI 103152 and featured in AFW March/April 2022.

Air Race Classic Team 10 Tennessee Flight Training Wins WAI Trophy and Prize Money

The 51 teams competing in the 45th Air Race Classic (ARC), the annual all-women cross-country airplane race, finished the 2,549-mile competition safely on Friday, June 24. WAI traveled to the terminus in Terre Haute, Indiana, to award the highest scoring team of all WAI members a trophy and \$500 check.
