

WAI Receives \$10,000 Grant from Bell

Funds used for Girls in Aviation Day participants about helicopters

September 28, 2018 – Women in Aviation International (WAI) has received a \$10,000 grant from Bell to help fund educational activities for WAI's Girls in Aviation Day. Specifically, this grant is used to provide helicopter-oriented editorial content in WAI's annual magazine *Aviation for Girls* and to provide hands-on educational activities including understanding rotary flight by experimenting with and flying whirly-gigs.
