



2024 WCMA MEMBERSHIP SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS





- On-Farm Biosecurity Grants: Applications Open August 13, First come, first served
 - 10 Reimbursable, no-match grants of up to \$10,000 to dairy farms to acquire essential supplies and equipment to prevent the on-farm spread of H5N1

- Ag Roads Improvement Program (ARIP): Applications due September 30th



Sen, Baldwin Advocates for Common Food Names



Senator Tammy Baldwin (D-WI) this week called on the Biden Administration to continue protecting Wisconsin cheesemakers' use of common food names like parmesan, asiago, and fontina in international markets. Baldwin's letter to U.S. Trade Representative Katherine Tai follows a recent trade agreement that allows U.S. cheese producers to sell their products in Chile using common food names.

WCMA Senior Director of Programs & Policy Rebekah Sweeney praised Baldwin's effort, noting that the use of these terms "provides clarity for international consumers and greater economic opportunity for farmers and processors." READ MORE...
