FDA Issues Guidance on Food Processor Protocol in the Event of COVID-19 Positive

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration has issued two guidance documents for food processors, one on <u>proper protocol</u>, in the event of an employee testing positive for COVID-19, and another on the use of face masks and shields

Please also note, the Dairy Food Safety Alliance, comprised of staff from the Wisconsin Cheese Makers Association, Center for Dairy Research, and Dairy Farmers of Wisconsin, has issued standard operating procedures for two key scenarios:

- When an employee is suspected/confirmed to have COVID-19
- When an employee confirmed to have COVID-19 returns to work

DFW, WDATCP, Farm Groups Launch Wisconsin Food and Farm Support Fund

Dairy Farmers of Wisconsin (DFW) and the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection, in partnership with farmer advocacy groups, today announced the launch of the Wisconsin Food and Farm Support Fund, which will collect support for Feeding Wisconsin and Harvest of Hope. Wisconsin Now Offering Extra Unemployment Aid

The Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development (DWD) announced yesterday is now distributing an extra \$600 per week in emergency unemployment benefits made available through the federal CARES Act. Emergency aid payments are retroactive to March 29, and will be made automatically, without additional application forms.

More than 1.2 million Wisconsinites have filed for unemployment aid. and DWD has distributed \$290 million in benefits, just since March 15.
