#### **SBA Revises PPP Loan Forgiveness Application**

The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) has released a<u>revised loan</u> <u>forgiveness application</u> and <u>associated instructions</u> for the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP). The form reflects changes mandated through Congressional action, offering <u>greater flexibility for business owners</u> who've made use of PPP aid.

## **CDC Issues Guidance on Use of Hand Sanitizer**

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) this week has released a <u>study and guidance on the proper use of hand sanitizer</u>, noting best practices are often not followed. Hand sanitizer should be at least 60 percent alcohol. To use it correctly, the CDC recommends rubbing the hand sanitizer between your hands for 30 seconds, until all the gel is dry. Hand sanitizer should cover the surface of your hands and your fingers.
