MHF Group Holdings Acquires La Crosse Agropur Plant



MHF Group Holdings, a subsidiary of Dallas-based Select Milk Producers Inc. and owner of the Mill Haven Foods family of companies, <u>last week announced</u> that it has purchased WCMA member Agropur's Custom Solutions and Contract Manufacturing business in La Crosse, Wisconsin. Mill Haven Foods opened in 2010 in New Lisbon, Wisconsin and was acquired by Select Milk in June 2022.

Brian Slater, CEO of Mill Haven Foods, and Mike Homewood, Vice President of Custom Solutions for Agropur Ingredients-Custom Solutions, said the deal will help the businesses expand their blended ingredient solutions and reach a wider customer base in the U.S. and internationally.

Congratulations to WCMA member Great Lakes Cheese, which yesterday celebrated the grand opening of its newest expansion in Abilene, Texas. Construction on the 286,500-square-foot packaging and distribution facility began in May 2021, creating hundreds-of-jobs in the surrounding community.



U.S. Dairy Exports Up 7 Percent in September

New data shows <u>U.S. dairy exports showed continued strong growth</u> this fall, with whey, cheese, and lactose setting new September records and export volume rising 7 percent that month. Whey shipments jumped 18 percent - the fourth straight month of year-over-year gains in the double digits. Butter exports also saw an increase of 49 percent ahead of an expected slowdown in the coming months.

Each participating manufacturer/processor will receive up to 30 hours of no-cost consultative services with Ryan Wucherer of MCT Dairies.

For new-to-export companies and cooperatives, consultations will include:

- Evaluations of their product line, helping to identify potential global customers;
- Direction to in-depth educational resources, such as ExporTech™;
- Aid in the creation of their export plan; and,
- Aid in the execution of their export plan through the completion of necessary export paperwork and by connecting the business with potential carriers and distributors.

For companies and cooperatives currently engaged in export activities, consultations will include:

- Evaluations and recommendations on refinements in their export business model;
- Identify areas for export growth;
- Aid in the execution of export plans; and,
- Recommendations on improvements in products, packaging, marketing, labeling, sales or distribution.


WCMA Grows Staff Team, Member Services


Save the Date for December WCMA Health & Safety Group Meeting

Dairy Business Builder Grant Applications Due Thursday

Applications are due by 5:00 p.m. (CT) this Thursday, November 10 for the latest round of <u>Dairy Business Builder grants</u> through the Dairy Business Innovation Alliance (DBIA), a collaborative partnership between WCMA and the Center for Dairy Research.

Reimbursement grants of up to \$100,000 each will be awarded to small- to medium-sized dairy farmers, manufacturers, and processors in Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, Ohio, South Dakota, Kansas, and Wisconsin. The awards aim to support recipients in diversifying on-farm activity, creating value-added products, enhancing dairy byproducts, and creating or enhancing dairy export programs.

Application materials, including a free webinar with helpful tips to build a strong proposal, are now <u>available online</u>. Successful applicants will be notified by December 15, 2022.

Apply for Dairy Processor Grants by January 30

Wisconsin dairy manufacturers and processors can <u>apply now through January 30 for a new round of Dairy Processor Grants</u> administered by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (WDATCP). The program, which aims to strengthen Wisconsin's dairy processing industry, saw its <u>funding doubled in the state budget</u> following successful advocacy efforts by WCMA.

In 2023, grants of up to \$50,000 each will be awarded following a competitive review process. Recipients will be required to match at least 20 percent of their grant amount. Questions may be directed to **WDATCP** staff.
