Assembly Hearing on Dairy Labeling Bills November 6

The Wisconsin State Assembly will hear testimony on <u>Assembly Bills 515</u> and <u>516</u> on Wednesday, November 6 at 10 a.m., and you are invited to join WCMA staff in speaking in favor of these proposals.

These proposals, authored by Senator Howard Marklein (pictured above, at left center) and State Representative Travis Tranel (pictured at right center), would ban the use of the word "milk" and "cheese" on plant-based products sold in Wisconsin.

Last week, WCMA President Dave Buholzer of Klondike Cheese Company (pictured at far right), member Ken Heiman of Nasonville Dairy (pictured at far left), and Executive Director John Umhoefer spoke in favor of these bills.
