Members of Congress Urge Stronger Stance on USMCA Enforcement

As U.S. trade officials consider a Canadian proposal to remedy the country's violation of the U.S.-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA), a bipartisan group of U.S. Representatives, including Rep. Ron Kind (WI-03), is <u>calling on the Biden</u>

<u>Administration</u> to reject Canada's proposed fix and push for deeper reforms. The proposal does nothing to equalize market access for U.S. dairy products in the country and "effectively preserve[s] the status quo," the lawmakers write.

As noted in a **previous WCMA e-newsletter**, an independent panel affirmed in January that Canada failed to uphold its obligation under USMCA to fairly administer tariff rate quotas (TRQs) on imported American dairy products.

Valley Queen Cheese Announces Largest Expansion in Company History



Congratulations to WCMA member Valley Queen Cheese on the <u>announcement of</u> <u>its \$195 million expansion</u> in Milbank, South Dakota - the largest in the company's 93-year history.

The project, which is planned to be fully operational by January 2025, will boost cheese production capacity by 125 million pounds and daily milk processing capacity of 3 million pounds. The company expects to hire 140 employees over three years to fully staff the expanded operation.

In addition to increasing capacity in Milbank, Valley Queen plans to establish a distribution center in western Wisconsin, which will allow for more efficiency and flexibility in transportation and logistics.



Westby Cooperative Creamery Invests \$1M to Process Acid Whey

Congratulations go to WCMA member Westby Cooperative Creamery, which this week <u>announced its plans</u> to invest \$1 million in new equipment to process acid whey, a byproduct of cottage cheese, into permeate and protein. The new infrastructure will enable the cooperative to minimize the amount of unprocessed acid whey for disposal. Westby plans to process 6.9 million gallons of whey in 2022.


