DBIA Awards \$1.7 Million to 38 Dairy Businesses

WCMA, together with the Center for Dairy Research, last week announced the 38 recipients of \$1.7 million in Dairy Business Builder grants through the Dairy Business Innovation Alliance (DBIA). The grants aim to encourage small- to medium-sized dairy businesses in the Upper Midwest to pursue innovative projects such as dairy farm diversification, on-farm processing, value-added product creation, and efforts to market dairy products for export.



The awardees include eight WCMA members:

- **Decatur Dairy** will undergo an expansion to increase production capability and create new market opportunities for farmers in its Decatur Swiss Co-Op.
- Marieke Gouda will build on its existing sales and marketing staff and capabilities as the company undergoes a major expansion.
- Milk Specialties Global will conduct a research study investigating the possible benefits of whey protein phospholipid concentrate (WPPC) on consumer stress, anxiety, and wellbeing.
- Pine River Pre-Pack will work to expand its Cold Pack, Clean Label Cold Pack, and Gourmet Snack Spread products into underdeveloped markets.
- Prairie Farms Dairy Caves of Faribault will purchase of an additional cheese vat, significantly boosting annual cheese production.
- Renard's Cheese will purchase a labeling machine to automate the labeling process and potentially double sales in the near future.
- Specialty Cheese Company will move toward a semi-automated cheese forming process for many of its artisanal cheese varieties.
- **Widmer's Cheese Cellars** will purchase new vats, replacing its 1950s-installed vats as part of a plant-wide modernization project.

The DBIA is supported by the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Including the awards listed above, since its inception as part of the 2018 Farm Bill, the DBIA has administered approximately \$3.6 million in grants to 79 dairy businesses in Illinois, Iowa, Minnesota, South Dakota, and Wisconsin. The program also offers technical assistance and education to dairy farmers and processors in the region.

Study Finds Economic Benefits from USDA Agricultural Export Programs

Two export programs administered by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) are

"highly effective at generating an extremely high return on investment," researchers say. The new study found that together with the efforts of industry groups, the Market Access Program (MAP) and the Foreign Market Development (FMD) program **generated \$45 billion annually** in economic output from 2002-2019. During the same period, MAP and FMD reportedly also generated an average annual increase of 225,800 jobs. For more, **read the full study online**.
