### WCMA Applauds Legislative Approval of Additional WIAE Funding

WCMA <u>applauds members of the legislature's Joint Finance Committee</u>, who last week voted to approve more than \$500,000 in funding to support the continued work of the <u>Wisconsin Initiative for Agricultural Exports (WIAE</u>). The program launched earlier this year at the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection with a bipartisan array of supporters, led by Governor Tony Evers, State Senator Joan Ballweg (R-Markesan), and State Representative Tony Kurtz (R-Wonewoc). WCMA members contributed impactful testimony a

In addition to educating dairy processors on the export process and supporting their participation in key trade shows and buyers' missions, the WIAE is also funding programs tailored to specific agricultural sectors, including <u>one run by WCMA</u> which offers free consultative services to dairy processors interested in starting or expanding their export endeavors. WCMA's effort also features an export workshop, planned for later this year, and an online library of export resources, including template forms, guidance documents, and a database of contacts.

The August 31 deadline is quickly approaching to submit project abstracts for a new round of Dairy Industry Impact grants through the <u>Dairy Business Innovation Alliance (DBIA)</u>, a partnership between WCMA and the Center for Dairy Research. Eligibility information and evaluation criteria are <u>now available online</u>.


Reimbursable grants of up to \$250,000 each will be awarded to dairy businesses in Illinois, Iowa, Minnesota, South Dakota, or Wisconsin. Successful Industry Impact grant applicants will be required to share the results of their project. In September, selected applicants will be invited to submit full grant proposals, which will be due November 3.

2023 WCMA Recognition Award Nominations Due August 31 Just one week remains to nominate dairy processing industry leaders for the <u>2023 WCMA</u> <u>Recognition Awards</u>. Submit your nominations by next Wednesday, August 31 and join WCMA in honoring those who have helped advance and improve the dairy industry.

The <u>WCMA Cheese Industry Champion Award</u> is given to industry leaders who, through their everyday business decisions, have created tremendous opportunity for others and spurred industry growth. Individuals to be considered are the CEOs, Directors, Presidents, and Vice Presidents of their companies who may not have cheesemaking obligations but lead and direct resources. In 2022, Jeff Giffin of Masters Gallery Foods and Bob and Richard Wagner of Weyauwega Food Products were recognized with this award.

The <u>WCMA Distinguished Service Award</u> recognizes supplier partner members who have played a significant role in building the success of the United States dairy industry, contributing innovations in dairy manufacturing. In 2022, WCMA presented this award to James Manning of EDCO Food Products and Art Zimmer of Caloris Engineering.

Our newest honor, the <u>WCMA Luminary Award</u>, recognizes the contributions of leaders in dairy product sales and marketing; individuals who introduced new concepts, products, or innovative ideas to drive sales in the U.S. or around the world. The 2022 recipients of the Luminary Award were Van Salmans of Salmans & Associates and Cathy Strange of Whole Foods Market.

The <u>WCMA Vanguard Award</u> is reserved for cheesemakers or cheese manufacturing employees who are considered groundbreakers for their innovations in day-to-day dairy operations. In 2022, Steve Ottiger of Alpine Alpa/Guggisberg Cheese and Steve Yeager of Hilmar Cheese Company were presented with this award.

The <u>WCMA Babcock Award</u> recognizes the contributions of those in education or affiliate organizations to partner with cheesemakers in the pursuit of dairy industry innovation and excellence. In 2022, this award went to Dr. Mark Johnson of the Center for Dairy Research at the University of Wisconsin-Madison and Dr. Paul Kindstedt of the University of Vermont.




