# **USDA Announces New Pandemic Aid Program**

U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Secretary Tom Vilsack yesterday announced a new, four-part <u>Pandemic Assistance for Producers</u> initiative, designed to address gaps and disparities in the distribution of previous aid.

USDA will devote at least \$6 billion to the program, including \$2.5 billion for a third round of Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP) aid, beginning April 5.

Vilsack noted that food processors will be eligible for aid to support the purchase of personal protective equipment (PPE). More details on that will follow in the weeks ahead and WCMA will keep members updated.

# **CDC Adds More Toolkit Materials in Spanish**



The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention this week added to its essential employers' vaccine communications toolkit, posting new resources in Spanish. Materials include fact sheets, printable posters, and information about how to secure a vaccination appointment.
