WCMA yesterday applauded the inauguration of the 2025-2026 class of state lawmakers today, including Rep. Jenna Jacobson (D-Oregon). Jacobson will serve as the <u>ranking Democrat on the Assembly Committee on Agriculture</u>, a committee that will <u>again be chaired</u> by WCMA Cheese Champion awardee Rep. Travis Tranel (R-Cuba City).

Senator Patrick Testin (R-Stevens Point), also a WCMA ally, is the new chair of the Senate Committee on Agriculture and Revenue. Senator Brad Pfaff (D-Onalaska), also a previous WCMA Cheese Champion, will serve as the ranking Democrat on that committee.
