Trump Says Tariffs on Canada, Mexico to Take Effect Next Week



President Donald Trump said Monday his administration plans to move forward with boosted tariffs on neighbors Canada and Mexico next week. Implementation had been delayed late in January by a month, but Trump noted the tariffs of 25 percent on all products from both countries will now move forward "on time, on schedule."

Canada and Mexico make up \$900 billion in U.S. imports, and are two of the nation's top three markets for agricultural products. Both Canadian and Mexican leaders are vowing retaliatory tariffs, though specific plans have not been made public. Mexico is the top export market for U.S. cheese, taking in 424 million pounds of U.S. cheese in 2024.

WCMA has advocated and will continue to push for members' interests, supporting greater opportunity for international trade.

Legislation Introduced to Mandate Production Cost Surveys



U.S. Senators Kirsten Gillibrand (D-NY) and Susan Collins (R-ME) this week introduced the Fair Milk Pricing for Farmers Act, a bipartisan effort aimed at increasing transparency in the dairy industry. The legislation would require manufacturers to report dairy processing costs every two years, ensuring that milk prices more accurately reflect production expenses. In the House, Representatives Nick Langworthy (R-NY 23) and Joe Morelle (D-NY 25) have introduced companion legislation. WCMA supports this proposal.

Trump Administration Firings to Impact Agriculture



Elon Musk's Department of Government Efficiency has directed a wave of terminations across the federal government, which are expected to impact the agricultural community. Below are summaries of reported impacts at the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

Jim Jones, head of FDA's food division, resigned last week, following the Trump Administration's decision to <u>fire 89 people in his department</u>, effectively dismantling the group. The division oversees food safety inspections and recalls. Late last week, some <u>FDA employees were notified</u> their recent terminations had been "rescinded effective immediately," according to messages viewed by The Associated Press.

As of this past weekend, the Trump Administration had directed the dismissal of 3,400 USDA employees, with the largest percentage of those workers serving in the U.S. Forest Service. The group also includes loan officers at Farm Service Agency, researchers, and administrators across all divisions. Among the firings were leaders in the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, working in key roles to address bird flu outbreaks nationwide; the Trump Administration now says it is working to rehire these individuals.

At the EPA, <u>388 workers were fired</u> last Friday. These dismissals come on top of the 168 people fired earlier this month from the agency's environmental justice office, which closed down following an executive order from the White House to end programs related to diversity, equality and inclusion.

Health & Human Services Delays "Healthy" Food Labeling Rule



The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services <u>announced today</u> it will delay by more than two months the implementation of a new rule regarding the definition of the nutrient content claim "healthy" that manufacturers can voluntarily use on food packages. The final rule is delayed until April 28 from February 25, a move designed to give Trump Administration officials the opportunity for further consideration of the new regulation.


