WCMA to Launch OSHA Alliance Thursday



Join WCMA this Thursday, October 17 at 10:30 a.m. in Middleton, Wisconsin for the official launch of our new alliance with the U.S. Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA).

An agreement detailing the partnership will be signed at a special news conference at the headquarters of WCMA member and event host Foremost Farms USA.

Building on the foundation laid by the WCMA Health & Safety Group, the alliance will pursue common goals in support of dairy processors' employee safety efforts, including:

- Sharing information on safety laws and standards and OSHA initiatives;
- Encouraging communication between OSHA and industry to provide input on issues and forge innovative safety solutions; and
- Developing resources for the dairy processing industry on common workplace hazards, worker rights, and employer responsibilities.

After the signing, WCMA's Health & Safety Group will meet to share more details of the alliance and explore key topics such as chemical safety and workplace violence prevention. The meeting also includes a networking lunch for in-person attendees. Registration is open now - join us!



New California H5N1 Human Cases Confirmed

The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) last week <u>confirmed a third human case</u> of highly pathogenic avian influenza (H5N1) in a California dairy farm worker. Samples from two additional suspected cases are being provided to the CDC now for confirmatory testing. If confirmed, the new cases will bring the total number of human H5N1 cases among dairy farm workers to 11, and the total number of human cases overall to 25.

On October 1, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) launched its unified Human Foods Program, a new model and name for field operations and modernization efforts. The FDA restructured and renamed the unit to focus on inspections, investigations, and imports as its core



mission. The reorganization of the Office of Inspections and Investigation (OII, previously known as the Office of Regulatory Affairs), extends beyond food and impacts how the FDA oversees all FDA-regulated products. READ MORE...
