USDA Announces \$15M to Boost Organic Dairy Access



WCMA this week cheered the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) direction of \$15 million to expand access to organic dairy products in schools and community youth programs.

At a news conference Monday in Vermont alongside the state's ag secretary Anson Tebbetts (see pictured), USDA Undersecretary Jenny Lester Moffitt noted the funding will be distributed through cooperative agreements with Dairy Business Innovation Initiatives, including the Dairy Business Innovation Alliance (DBIA) run by the Center for Dairy Research and WCMA.

DBIA anticipates offering grants to organic dairy manufacturers before the end of this year. **READ MORE...**



H5N1 Milk Silo Survey Testing Begins

A <u>voluntary milk silo survey</u> organized by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA), and the National Conference on Interstate Milk



Shipments (NCIMS) launches this week, with a goal of determining the prevalence of H5N1 infection in U.S. dairy herds. Testing will occur in at least 33 states, with additional states able to join the effort through the third week of the six-week-long survey, scheduled to wrap in early December. State departments of agriculture are or will be contacting dairy processors to alert them to upcoming testing. Sampling and survey results will be double blinded, meaning sampled facilities cannot be identified.

New H5N1 Human Cases Reported in California



Health officials last week confirmed a new human case of highly pathogenic avian influenza (H5N1) in a dairy farm worker in Merced County, California. This brings the state's total confirmed human cases to 16, more than any other state. The California Department of Public Health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reiterated that the commercial millk supply is safe, and that the risk to the general public of contracting H5N1 is low. As a reminder, the CDC <u>recommends</u> that anyone working with raw milk - including milk haulers and dairy processing personnel involved in raw milk handling - wear personal protective equipment (PPE). <u>Recommended PPE</u> for these individuals includes a NIOSH-approved particulate respirator such as an N95, eye protection, and gloves. They must also thoroughly wash their hands after raw milk contact.

USDA Issues Draft Yogurt CRD, Issues Cheddar Contract

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has issued a revised <u>Commodity Requirements</u> <u>Document (CRD) for yogurt products</u>, with comments and questions due to <u>USDA staff</u> today, October 29.

USDA has also <u>awarded a contract</u> to WCMA member Associated Milk Producers Inc. to provide over 693,000 pounds of cheddar cheese for use in federal food distribution programs.
