Federal Shutdown Stalemate Risks Key Nutrition Aid



Day Seven of the <u>federal government</u> <u>shutdown</u> is underway with no deal in sight, as Democrats continue to hold out for an extension in expiring Affordable Care Act subsidies. In a reversal Monday, President Donald Trump indicated a new openness to negotiating a deal, though there are no signs of significant progress at the time of this newsletter distribution.

WCMA is advocating for a resolution on federal funding that preserves key functions at USDA, FDA, and other industry-reliant agencies, as well as for continued aid for nutrition programs. While school nutrition programs and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) have support to continue for at least a month, the \$8 billion Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) program is now operating on a contingency fund of just \$150 million, which could run out in a week.
