### **USDA Announces \$285M in Export Grant Funding**



The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) announced Thursday \$285 million in grant funding for trade promotion activities by state departments of agriculture, as well as non-profit trade groups. WCMA called for such an expansion of federal dairy trade promotion programs in our 2025 Dairy Trade Policy Platform, and will continue to share future developments with members. READ MORE...

## U.S. Senate Passes Whole Milk for Healthy Kids Act



The U.S. Senate has passed the Whole Milk for Healthy Kids Act of 2025, a bill that restores the option for schools participating in the National School Lunch Program to once again serve whole milk and 2% milk. The bill also clarifies that fluid milk no longer needs to be included in the overall saturated fat calculation for school meals. WCMA has advocated in support of this legislation, and will continue to monitor its progress as it moves to the House.

## **USDA Seeks Cheese Products; Updates Master Solicitation**

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has issued solicitations for a variety of cheese products to be used in domestic food distribution programs:

- Cheddar Products
- Mozzarella String Cheese
- Yogurt and Butter
- Processed Cheese Products

The deadline for all four solicitations is December 2 at 1:00 p.m. (CT). USDA also released an updated <u>Master Solicitation for Domestic Commodity Procurements</u>, effective September 18, 2025, which provides general guidance for potential bidders. **READ MORE...**


