First Policy Institute, as head of the agency.

USDA Revises Yogurt CRD

Following industry comment, the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has issued a <u>revised</u>

<u>Commodity Requirements Document (CRD) for yogurt products.</u> The revisions reflect a regulatory cap placed on added sugars, new container and packaging color requirements, and new material code. Questions may be directed to <u>USDA staff</u>.


