FDA Shares Additional Detail on Previous Retail Sample Survey

Following earlier findings that 297 retail dairy product samples all tested negative for viable HPAI/H5N1 virus, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) yesterday provided additional information on this retail sample survey. The update, which includes a list of states where each milk sample was processed, sheds further light on the agency's sampling and analysis procedures. It does not provide any new test results or guidance. **READ MORE...**

House Agriculture Chair Releases Farm Bill Draft

On Friday, House Committee on Agriculture Chairman Glenn Thompson (R-PA15, pictured) unveiled the <u>House version of the Farm Bill</u>, with a committee mark-up planned for this week.

According to a <u>line-by-line summary</u> from Chairman Thompson, the draft proposes cuts to food aid and climate change programs, authorizes but does not set a funding level for the Dairy Business Innovation Initiatives (DBII), and



restores "higher of" Class 1 milk pricing. It also includes several WCMA-supported priorities, such as a biennial cost survey to maintain milk pricing reform, makes the Dairy Forward Pricing Program permanent, and requires protection of common food names for cheese in trade agreements.
