USDA Expands H5N1 Aid for Dairy Producers

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) <u>last week announced</u> forthcoming plans to compensate dairy producers for milk production losses due to highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI or H5N1) at 90 percent of lost production per cow for a set time period. The agency said it will soon issue a rule with specific funding and eligibility details. USDA also said it is expanding eligibility for a previously announced \$98 million in existing aid to include producers whose herds have not tested positive for H5N1. <u>READ MORE...</u>

U.S. Senator Tammy Baldwin (D-WI) has <u>appealed for H5N1 aid specifically for dairy processors</u> and WCMA will keep members informed of any relevant updates.

Michigan Dairy Farmworker Tests Positive for H5N1

An employee on a Michigan dairy farm has tested positive for H5N1, <u>state health officials said</u> <u>Friday</u>. The worker, who had regular exposure to dairy cows infected with H5N 1, had mild symptoms and has recovered.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) are <u>recommending personal protective</u> <u>equipment</u> for anyone handling unpasteurized milk, including hauling and processing workers.

House Committee Approves Farm Bill Draft

Late Thursday night, the House Committee on



Agriculture voted to approve <u>its version of the Farm</u> <u>Bill</u>, opting to maintain current funding authorization for the Dairy Business Innovation Initiatives (DBII).

An amendment to boost that support to \$36 million was introduced by Congressman Derrick Van Orden (R-WI 03), but ultimately withdrawn after Committee Chairman Glenn Thompson (R-PA 15) committed to seeking additional support for DBII via the Farm Bill legislative process. READ MORE...

The House bill expands Healthy Fluid Milk Incentives Projects, adding 2 percent and whole milk to offerings, but does not include cheese and yogurt. The bill also calls for mandated biennial cost surveys to inform federal orders, makes the Dairy Forward Pricing Program permanent, and protects common food names.

While the <u>Senate's detailed framework</u> for its version of the Farm Bill has been released and includes \$36 million per year for DBII, the bill draft has yet to be shared, and changes in committee are expected. The U.S. Department of Agriculture has <u>awarded contracts</u> to WCMA members Associated Milk Producers Inc., Bongards Creameries, Land O'Lakes, and Winona Foods to deliver more than 1.3 million pounds of cheddar cheese for federal nutrition programs.
