Contact Lawmakers to Urge Action on Farm Bill



In a sign of forward progress, the U.S. House and Senate Ag Committees last week released their framework proposals for the new Farm Bill. The House released <u>limited details</u> on its proposal, and is expected to share more by the end of the week. The Senate's <u>proposal</u> offered more specifics, including \$36 million in annual funding for Dairy Business Innovation Initiatives, mandatory dairy plant cost studies to support milk pricing reform, and added funding for dairy exports. Research Reaffirms Pasteurization Effectiveness Against HPAI



U.S. federal agencies last week announced additional results from its latest research, reaffirming the effectiveness of pasteurization in inactivating the HPAI virus in fluid milk, cottage cheese, and sour cream. The study also found no detection of the HPAI virus or viral fragments in powdered infant formula. READ MORE...
