New H5N1 Fact Sheet Available for Dairy Processing Workers



The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (WDHS) has created a <u>new fact sheet</u> to help support dairy processors' efforts to keep their valued employees safe during the outbreak of H5N1 in dairy cows.

This <u>free resource</u>, <u>created with input from WCMA</u>, offers safety tips on key topics including personal protective equipment, pasteurization, and disinfecting protocols.

H5N1 Reported in Minnesota, Iowa Dairy Herds

lowa and Minnesota agriculture officials <u>last</u> <u>week reported</u> the states' first cases of H5N1 in dairy herds. The cases are currently pending confirmation by the National Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory.

If confirmed, the detections bring the **total count** of affected U.S. states to 11, with H5N1



confirmed in 83 herds across the country. Two dairy farm workers in Michigan and one in Texas have tested positive for the virus, including one who reported respiratory symptoms.

Also last week, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued a <u>letter to all state, territorial, and tribal partners</u> offering recommendations regarding the sale and consumption of raw milk amid the H5N1 outbreak. WCMA will continue to keep members informed of further developments in this newsletter and at <u>WisCheeseMakers.org</u>.
