WCMA Applauds U.S. Senate Committee Action to Fund Dairy Innovation, H5N1 Response

On Thursday, WCMA <u>cheered a</u>
<u>successful effort</u> from Senator Tammy
Baldwin (D-Wisconsin) to boost funding for



Dairy Business Innovation Initiatives (DBII) from the proposed funding of \$12 million to \$17 million in the Senate version of the Fiscal Year 2025 agricultural appropriations package.

Baldwin, at WCMA's request, also included language directing USDA to divert monies to DBII centers for H5N1 response.

The Senate ag appropriations package provides a total of \$27 billion in funding, with increased funding for agricultural research and nutrition programs as well. The Senate proposes a \$1 million increase to \$4 million for Healthy Fluid Milk Incentives projects, another WCMA priority.

WCMA is working with members to secure additional FY25 funding for DBII in the House of Representatives. Complete WCMA's simple form now to tell your lawmakers in Congress that you support dairy businesses!

OSHA Issues H5N1 Hazard Alert

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has published a new Hazard Alert on H5N1 (Avian Influenza) in Dairy Cattle, in coordination with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH). Oklahoma Reports First H5N1 Positive in Dairy Herds

Oklahoma is the latest U.S. state where dairy cows have tested positive for H5N1, <u>officials confirmed yesterday</u>. The news brings the total number of U.S. states with affected herds to 13, including Colorado, Idaho, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, New Mexico, North Carolina, Ohio, South Dakota, Texas, and Wyoming. <u>READ MORE...</u>

USDA Issues Solicitations, Seeks Input on Mozzarella CRD

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has issued a solicitation for the procurement of <u>cheddar</u> <u>cheese</u>, with bids due tomorrow, Wednesday, July 17 at 1:00 p.m. (CT). Questions may be directed to <u>USDA staff</u>.

USDA has also issued a solicitation for <u>yogurt and butter</u>, with bids due Monday, July 29 at 1:00 p.m. (CT). Questions may be directed to <u>USDA staff</u>.

A third solicitation, issued this week, seeks bids for <u>process cheese</u>, with bids due Tuesday, July 23 at 1:00 p.m. (CT). Questions may be directed to <u>USDA staff</u>.

USDA also <u>announced plans on Thursday</u> to purchase Swiss cheese, instant nonfat dry milk, and ultra-high temperature milk for distribution to various food nutrition assistance programs. Solicitation documents are expected to be available online soon. Questions may be directed to <u>USDA staff</u>.

The agency also seeks industry input by July 19 on its **Draft Mozzarella Cheese Commodity Requirements Document** (CRD). Those with questions may contact **USDA staff**.
