Dairy Economists Publish Analyses of FMMO Recommendations

Three new Information Letters describing and analyzing the impacts of the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Recommended Decision on Federal Milk Marketing Order (FMMO) reforms are now available online. Produced by the Dairy Markets and Policy team at the University of Wisconsin, the letters offer insights on USDA's recommendations regarding <u>make allowances</u>, <u>Class I differentials</u>, and <u>the elimination of Order 30 for farm milk prices</u>.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has issued a solicitation for the procurement of <u>mozzarella</u> <u>string cheese</u>, with bids due Wednesday, July 31 at 1:00 p.m. (CT). Questions may be directed to <u>USDA staff</u>.

USDA has also <u>awarded contracts</u> to WCMA members Associated Milk Producers Inc. and Bongards Creameries to deliver more than 1.4 million pounds of cheddar cheese for federal nutrition programs.
