Colorado Dairy Farmworker Tests Positive for HPAI

An employee on a Colorado dairy farm is the fourth person nationwide and the first in that state to test

positive for HPAI in connection with the H5N1 outbreak among dairy herds, <u>health officials said</u> <u>Wednesday</u>. The employee, who had regular exposure to dairy cows infected with the virus, reported eye symptoms and has since recovered with antiviral treatment.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommend <u>personal protective equipment</u> for anyone handling unpasteurized milk, including hauling and processing workers. Additional H5N1 resources for dairy processors are available at <u>WisCheeseMakers.org</u>.
