Feds Encourage Voluntary Milk Sampling at Processing Plants



In a letter sent last week, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), National Conference on Interstate Milk Shipments (NCIMS), and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) asked State Departments of Agriculture to engage in a voluntary six-week silo sampling study to determine the prevalence of H5N1 in raw milk at dairy processing facilities.

READ THE LETTER

WCMA staff are engaged with federal and state officials to better understand how samples might be collected and tested, and what would be done with resulting information. We are also communicating with state departments of agriculture to determine which of them might participate in this voluntary effort. WDATCP Opens Dairy Processor Grant Application Window



Dairy processors operating in Wisconsin can apply now through October 7 for <u>Dairy</u> <u>Processor Grants</u> of up to \$50,000 each. A total of \$500,000 is available through the program, which is administered by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (WDATCP). **READ MORE...**

WDOJ Seeks Information on Fraud Against Cheesemakers

The Wisconsin Department of Justice (WDOJ) seeks information about a scam targeting dairy processors involving fraudulent shipments. The scammers use publicly available information to have truckloads of cheese shipped to New York. There, the loads are intercepted and stored at another location, while the manufacturer never receives payment. WCMA members who have experienced this scam or have any relevant information should **contact WDOJ Special Agent Denny Carroll**.

WDOJ advises WCMA members to independently check email addresses and phone numbers using open-source searching, rather than relying on the information provided. Manufacturers should also inform recipients that trucks will not be re-routed to any location without verification, and that last-minute changes will therefore result in delivery delays.


