New Report Emphasizes Importance of Cybersecurity for Wisconsin Manufacturers



In a new report, "Growth Opportunities in Manufacturing," the Wisconsin Center for Manufacturing & Productivity (WCMP says cybersecurity may be the "Achilles' heel" for manufacturers as online threats become more sophisticated thanks to Al. Last year, 39 percent of manufacturing companies with 50 or more employers were hacked, marking a 129 percent increase from 2021, according to the report. Meanwhile, 17 percent of those with fewer than 50 employers were hacked last year - a 13 percent increase from 2021. READ MORE...


