No H5N1 Detections in Nation's Livestock in Last 30 Days



The U.S. Department of Agriculture last week <u>confirmed zero detections</u> of highly pathogenic avian influenza (H5N1) in zero states in the last 30 days. The Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (WDATCP) added that <u>H5N1 has not been detected in any of the milk samples collected</u> as part of the National Milk Testing Program since the program's launch in May of this year. 
