

Chapter Development Application Process

Applications for new WiM Chapters currently accepted until

April 30, 2025

- At least 100 current individual WiM members located in the state
 or region that the chapter will represent. The following leadership
 team roles must be filled: Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer, Secretary,
 Marketing Director, Membership Director, Events Director,
 Sponsorship Director.
- All proposed chapter leaders must be current members of WiM.
- At least 50% of the chapter leadership team must work for a manufacturing company.
- At least three (3) different companies (manufacturing or other) must be represented on the chapter's proposed leadership team

CHAPTER UPDATES & REMINDERS

UPDATES TO THE CHAPTER EVENT FORM – ALCOHOL LIABILITY COVERAGE

All chapter events will require additional information from the chapter if alcohol will be served during an event. PLEASE NOTE: Chapters <u>are permitted</u> to host events where attendees are served alcohol, however, additional insurance coverage for the event is required.

The following questions have been added or updated on the **Chapter Event Information Form**:

Which of the following applied to this event (Select all that apply):

- A. Attendees will pay the event venue for alcohol directly; The chapter is not purchasing alcohol for attendees. NO ADDITIONAL COVERAGE REQUIRED.
- B. Attendees will pay the chapter to register, then the chapter will pay the venue for alcohol. ADDITIONAL COVERAGE REQUIRED.
- C. Attendees will pay chapter, then the chapter will buys and/or serves alcohol to attendees directly ADDITIONAL COVERAGE REQUIRED.

If B and/or C are selected, then you will be asked:

- What is the estimated total revenue to be collected for alcohol sales? Please Note: This is the dollar amount the chapter expects to spend on alcohol for the event and can be an estimate.
- What is the minimum liability insurance required by the event venue? Please Note: The venue for the event should be able to provide this information to the chapter upon request. WiM cannot open registration and/or promote an event without this information, which should be a dollar amount.

We also encourage the chapter's Chair or Vice Chair to attend a session, to ensure multiple leaders are informed on the processes and can assist as needed. Programs includes a monthly speaker series, three cohortbased leadership development programs, and a bi-annual virtual career fair


Each year, more than 350 women graduate from WiMEF leadership development programs, 600 participate in the career fair, and 5,000 join our speaker series

IDEAS AND CONCEPTS

Standard annual donation providing strategically nimble funding to increase WiMEF impact

Annual challenge to support program expansion, growth, innovation: WiP, Management Development, Leadership Institute, Virtual Learning Series, Virtual Career Fair, operations

Underwrite expenses: \$300,000⁺/year for Women in Production discounts to WiM members; Speaker fees for instructors/presenters/facilitators (all women!) \$48,000/year; Governance (state registrations & compliance, software) \$25,000/year

Develop new nationwide program connecting chapters to local girls in STEM or work-based learning

Chapters use WiMEF as a speaker's bureau to source presenters for meetings, lectures, webinars

Partnership to engage/recruit new members to chapters
