

Why it Matters

*"Having female leaders in positions of influence to serve as role models is not only critical to the career advancement of women but stands to generate broader societal impacts on pay equity, changing workplace policies in ways that benefit both men and women, and attracting a more diverse workforce."*The Rockefeller Foundation: "Women in Leadership: Why it Matters"

- 72% of manufacturers agree that DEI is a key focus for their companies
 - Only one in four management positions in manufacturing are held by women
- 79% of women say leadership training and mentorship are the biggest factors for success in their careers
 - Only 20% of mfg companies offer leadership training and only 13% offer mentorship

BRIDGE OPERATIONS GAPS

The WiMEF has operating costs that are not covered through registration fees or grant funding – we rely on a community of support to help us do our work.

KEEP PROGRAMS AFFORDABLE

While costs have increased, WiMEF has never increased registration fees. Donations help us keep WiMEF programs affordable and accessible.

KEEP PROGRAMS ACCESSIBLE

All WiMEF programs have waitlists and with donations we can increase program capacity and cadence. In 2023, with contributions from donors like you, we were able to admit 109 additional women to leadership development programs!


