



CHAPTERS BY THE NUMBERS

- Events Since April 1, 2022: **179** (81% to goal of 220)
 - 148 In-person
 - 31 Virtual
- Events scheduled through remainder of FY22: 19 (90% to goal of 220 – Need 22 additional events!)
- 3,360 Unique Registrants (84% to goal of 4,000)
- 1,608 Unique Companies (80% to goal of 2,000)
- Event Survey Feedback
 - 250 responses received
 - Attendees from events produced by 18 Chapters


