

- Corporate member companies
- Connect with Your Local MEP Center

#### **Contracts & Fees**

- WiM National typically pays for our speakers' hotel and travel accommodations, but WiM avoids paying speaking fees or honorariums whenever possible.
- You are valuable to your speakers!
  - Audience & Demographics Social Media and Members
  - Traffic to chapter webpage or event pages
  - Crazy SEO
