Paul is currently Vice President Site Operations, Amgen Dun Laoghaire (ADL).

Paul joined Amgen at ADL in May 2011 as Director Information Systems (IS). He held a variety of roles in IS and Operations improvement before moving into Manufacturing in 2015. Paul became Plant Manager at ADL in 2017 with responsibility for all manufacturing and related engineering activities.
