



Women in Manufacturing Hall of Fame Criteria and Selection Process

Criteria:

The Women in Manufacturing Hall of Fame honors women who have made outstanding contributions during the course of their established careers in manufacturing. Recipients include women who are dedicated to supporting, promoting, and inspiring women in the manufacturing industry, based on one or more of the following criteria:

1. Support

Nominee has demonstrated how they have significantly supported women within their companies, industry and throughout their career.

2. Promote

Nominee has directly made an exceptional contribution to the advancement of women in manufacturing and has actively promoted and advocated for women's advancement within their companies, industry and throughout their career.

3. Inspire

Nominee has been a spokesperson for careers in manufacturing and the important role that women hold in this industry through one or more of the following opportunities: mentoring, panel participation, speaking engagements, and participation in women's organizations.

How Inductees Are Selected:

The Women in Manufacturing Education Foundation (WiMEF) Executive Committee makes up the panel of the Women in Manufacturing Hall of Fame judges.

After the nominations submission deadline, the judging panel is provided with detailed information on each nominee provided by nominators. The judges then electronically review each nominee and answer a set list of questions that cover the awards criteria, rating each section on a scale of 1 through 5. Nominations are judged by the panel and votes are submitted to WiM staff for final review prior to determining the award winners.

How Inductees Are Notified:

After the voting has taken place and inductees have been determined, WiM's president will reach out to each inductee via e-mail to inform them of the award.

For those who are selected, **within one week's time** are required to:

- Confirm the accuracy of the submitted materials/information included in the entry
- Notify us of attendance for the Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony and Gala taking place on October 6, 2021, in Cleveland, OH (following the WiM SUMMIT).
- Notify us if there will be a representative to claim the award at the Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony and Gala
