Women in Production is a 20-week, virtual program providing leadership development and durable skills to team members working in production, production support, and shop floor roles. These skills are essential to build thriving careers, successful workplaces, and a resilient manufacturing workforce.

Audience

The program is ideal for newer team members or those with leadership potential but limited leadership experience. Common job titles include production/shift supervisor, assembler, operator, technician, line owner, engineer, and team lead.
