





Program Overview:

The Empowering Women in Production program is a virtual course designed to support the professional development of production floor employees. Employees in production settings often have tremendous insight into the culture, products, and processes that manufacturing companies need to understand to innovate. By developing these women into leaders, we can improve the industry overall and inspire other women to explore careers in manufacturing.

The program is geared for newer team members and/or those that are identified as having leadership potential, but no current leadership experience. Examples of participating roles include: engineering administrator, sales manager, executive assistant, operational prefect, associate manager, office manager, and industry analyst.

Program Audience:

Women in production, direct production support, and shop-floor roles in manufacturing

Program Format

100% Virtual

Recorded lessons are released throughout the program (see dates) so participants can learn at their own pace on their own time with a 60-minute time commitment each week

Professional Development

The program also includes a StrengthsFinders skills assessment, four sessions of one-on-one coaching with a certified coach, and monthly peer discussions to build a robust professional network.
