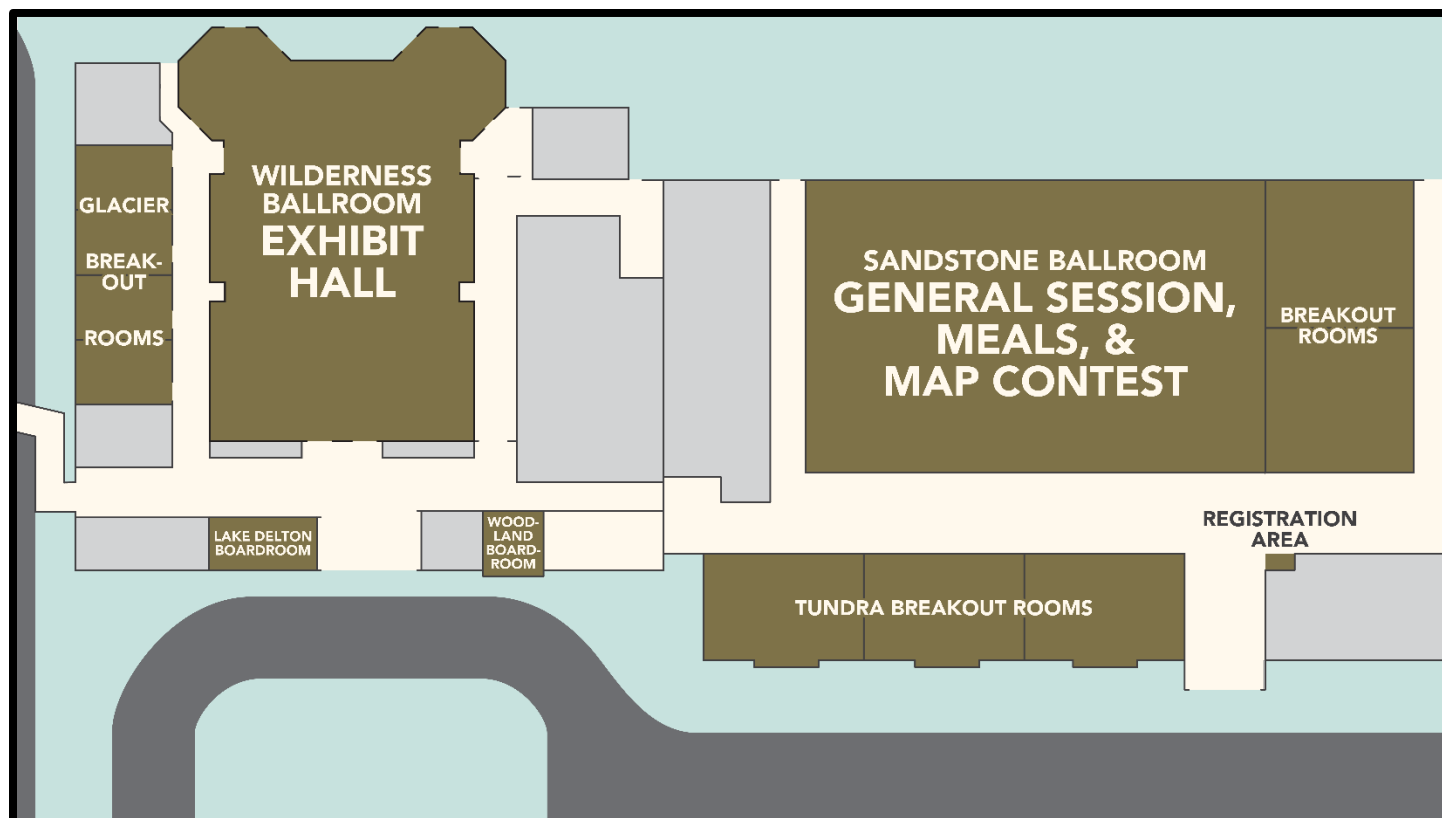

Physical Arrangement of Exhibits

Exhibits shall be arranged to not interfere with access to other exhibits and to provide clear and sufficient use of all aisles.

Exhibitors are to maintain their exhibits in a clean, orderly, and safe manner.

Cancellation of Booth Space

Space may be canceled or reduced by Exhibitor. Cancellation fees apply as listed below.

- a) Before Feb. 5, 2026, a cancellation fee of \$300 will be retained by WLIA.
- b) Between Feb. 5 and Feb 19, one-half of the total price will be retained by WLIA.
- c) After Feb. 19, 2026, the total price will be retained by WLIA.

Product Sales

The Exhibitor assumes responsibility for securing all appropriate licenses for the sale of merchandise and is solely responsible for the collection of all applicable state and local taxes.

Security

The Exhibition Area will be secured during non-exhibit hours.

The Exhibitor assumes all responsibility and agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold blameless the WLIA, its officers, directors, employees, servants, and agents against any claims, demands, costs, loss, or expense, including attorney fees, litigation expenses, or court costs arising out of the use of the exhibition premises.

Electrical

Electrical wiring must conform with all federal, state, and local government requirements, including the National Electric Code Safety Rules.

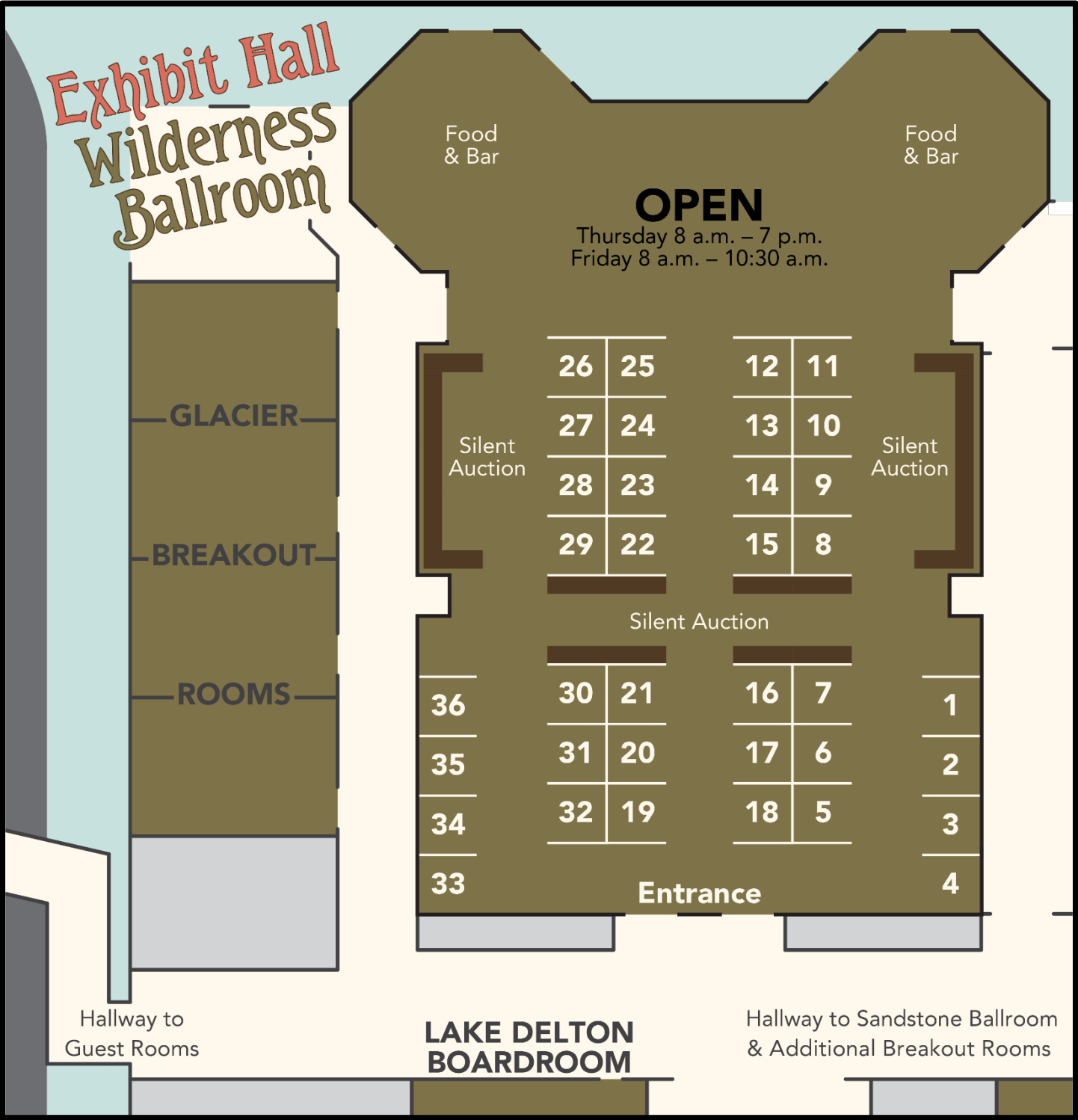
